



# DSWD DROMIC Report #5 on the Armed Conflict in Jovellar, Albay

as of 25 April 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 28 March 2024 at around 9:30 PM, an armed conflict transpired in barangays of San Vicente and Villa Paz in the municipality of Jovellar, Albay between thirty (30) members of the Communist National Terrorists (CNTs) and the joint forces of Albay 1<sup>st</sup> Provincial Mobile Force Company (PMFC), 505m MC, Regional Mobile Force Battalion 5 and Philippine Army.

# **II.** Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **136 families** or **586 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Jovellar**, **Albay** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **99 families** or **380 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2)** evacuation centers in Jovellar, Albay (see Annex B).

## **IV.** Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱899,822.28** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱795,272.28** from **DSWD**, and **₱104,550.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex E).
