





DSWD DROMIC Report #5 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City

as of 28 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 April 2024 at around 4:16 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 10:16 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **274 families** or **738 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **56 families** or **129 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **City Central Night High School** in **Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **218 families** or **609 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **274 families** or **738 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **91 houses** were damaged; of which, **82** are **totally damaged** and **nine (9)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Sambag II, Cebu City** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱10,779,970.10 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱4,542,185.10 from DSWD and ₱6,237,785.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).

12 April 2024	DSWD FO VII through its Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) provided technical assistance to the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) and the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO) of Cebu City relative to data collection and validation.
