

## DSWD DROMIC Report on the Effects of Closed Season of Fishing in Roxas City, Capiz

12 April 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

The Local Government Unit (LGU) of Roxas in Capiz declared November 15 to March 15 as closed season of fishing every year. This prohibits the fishing for sardines, herrings, and mackerels, angel wings, tarab, abalone, kapis shell, ballad, and nylon shell which eventually affected the livelihood of fisherfolks and shell harvesters in the affected areas.
