

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Granada, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental

I. Situation Overview

On 25 March 2024 at around 3:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Granada, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 4:45 PM.

One (1) family or four (4) persons temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Granada, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱12,716.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱8,426.00** from **DSWD** and **₱4,290.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
