I. Situation Overview

On 24 March 2024 at around 4:47 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Ibaba, Malabon City. The fire was declared out at around 6:20 AM.

A total of **19 families** or **73 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Ibaba, Malabon City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **19 families** or **73 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Ibaba, Malabon City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P97,447.77** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
