





DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Nasuli, San Remigio, Antique

04 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 22 March 2024 at around 3:10 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Nasuli, San Remigio, Antique. According to the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), the cause of fire was allegedly due to a faulty electrical wire. It was declared fire out at around 3:55 PM.

One (1) house was partially damaged in Brgy. Nasuli, San Remigio, Antique (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱4,337.78** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱2,837.78** from **DSWD** and **₱1,500.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex C).
