I. Situation Overview

On 24 March 2024 at around 2:15 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. San Fernando, Barotac Viejo, Iloilo. The fire was declared out at around 3:10 AM.

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. San Fernando, Barotac Viejo, Iloilo (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱16,212.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
