I. Situation Overview

On 21 March 2024 at around 9:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tortosa, Manapla, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 10:35 AM.

One (1) family or four (4) persons were affected in Brgy. Tortosa, Manapla, Negros Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or four (4) persons temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was partially damaged in Brgy. Tortosa, Manapla, Negros Occidental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱10,086.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱7,086.00** from **DSWD** and **₱3,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
