





# DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tugatog, Malabon City

18 April 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 20 March 2024 at around 7:06 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Tugatog, Malabon City. The fire was declared out at around 8:12 AM.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **eight (8) families** or **30 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Tugatog, Malabon City** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

## a. Inside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or six (6) persons are currently taking shelter at the Brgy. Tugatog Hall in Malabon City (see Annex B).

## **b. Outside Evacuation Center**

A total of **seven (7) families** or **24 persons** are staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

## c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **eight (8) families** or **30 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Tugatog, Malabon City** (see Annex D)

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **seven (7) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy Tugatog**, **Malabon Cityal City** (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P41,030.64** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
