

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Quintin Remo, Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental

06 April 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 April 2024 at around 7AM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Quintin Remo, Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental between the troops of the Philippine Army (PA) and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines – New People’s Army (CPP-NPA) which resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

A total of **63 families** or **275 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Quintin Remo, Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **63 families** or **275 persons** sought temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Quintin Remo, Moises Padilla, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱335,020.14** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
