

## **DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Jovellar, Albay**

16 October 2024, 6AM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 28 March 2024 at around 9:30 PM, an armed conflict transpired in Jovellar, Albay between the joint forces of Albay 1<sup>st</sup> Provincial Mobile Force Company (PMFC), 505m MC, Regional Mobile Force Battalion 5 and Philippine Army and members of the Communist NPA Terrorists (CNTs) of Jovellar, Albay resulted in the displacement of families / individuals and several reported casualties.

On March 29, 2024, a series of armed encounter again occurred in Brgy. San Vicente, and Brgy. Villa Paz, Jovellar Albay.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region V, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **136 families** or **586 persons** were affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Jovellar, Albay** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

A total of **136 families** or **586 persons** sought temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Jovellar, Albay** (see Annex B).

### **IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱899,822.28** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱795,272.28** from **DSWD** and **₱104,550.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex E).
