

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict within the Boundaries of Pilar, Abra and Santa Maria, Ilocos Sur

21 May 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 02 April 2024, an armed conflict transpired between the government troops of the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) within the boundaries of Pilar, Abra and Santa Maria, Ilocos Sur. According to reports, the armed encounter had significant impact on the livelihood of the families and individuals in the affected areas.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **593 families** or **1,922 persons** were affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Pilar, Abra** and **two (2) barangays** in **Santa Maria, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **327 families** or **1,130 persons** sought temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Pilar, Abra** and **one (1) evacuation center** in **Santa Maria, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **17 families** or **77 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **344 families** or **1,207 persons** were displaced in **Pilar, Abra and Santa Maria, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex E).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱5,318,284.75** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱2,772,673.75** from **DSWD**, **₱428,810.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)**, **₱168,700.00** from **NGOs**, and **₱1,948,101.00** from **Other Partners** (see Annex F).
