



DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Easterlies in North Cotabato

29 April 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 March 2024, the effects of Easterlies were reported in the Municipalities of Kabacan, Libungan, and Pigcawayan in North Cotabato. The Easterlies brought a significant amount of rain associated with strong winds which resulted to the displacement of families and persons.

Relative to the incident, DSWD Field Office XII provided relief and financial assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals. Moreover, the local government assumes the management of Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) and commits to continuously provide intervention as necessary hence, the termination of this report.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **313 families** or **1,430 persons** are affected in **17 barangays** in **North Cotabato** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **31 families** or **153 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **298 houses** were damaged; of which, **69** are **totally damaged** and **229** are **partially damaged** in **North Cotabato** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱507,040.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
