

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Lomboy, San Joaquin, Iloilo

22 May 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 22 March 2024 at around 12:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Lomboy, San Joaquin, Iloilo. The fire was declared out at around 1:20 PM

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **six (6) families** or **27 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Lomboy, San Joaquin, Iloilo** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **four (4) families** or **19 persons** sought temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Lomboy, San Joaquin, Iloilo** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **two (2) persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **five (5) families** or **21 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Lomboy, San Joaquin, Iloilo** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **seven (7) houses** were damaged; of which, **six (6) are totally damaged** and **one (1) is partially damaged** in **Brgy. Lomboy, San Joaquin, Iloilo** (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱41,508.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex G).
