





# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Nazareth, Cagayan de Oro, Misamis Oriental

05 April 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 15 February 2024 at around 1:38 PM, a fire incident occurred at 31<sup>st</sup> St., Ramonal Village, Brgy. Nazareth, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 3:01 PM.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region X, together with the Cagayan de Oro City Social Welfare and Development Office, promptly provided relief assistance composed of food and non-food items (FNIs) and established a community kitchen to support the immediate needs of the affected families.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 115 families or 407 persons are affected in Brgy. Nazareth, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

A total of **58 families** or **290 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **Barangay Nazareth Gymnasium** in **Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **65 houses** were damaged; of which, **60** are **totally damaged** and **five (5)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Nazareth, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}\$1,163,447.50 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; composed of \$\mathbb{P}\$910,397.50 from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}\$253,050.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
