I. Situation Overview

On 29 April 2024 at around 7PM, a fire incident occurred at M. Rodriguez, Brgy. La Huerta, Parañaque City. The fire was declared out at around 9:21 PM.

A total of **35 families** or **122 persons** are affected in **Brgy. La Huerta, Parañaque City** (see Annex A).

A total of **17 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. La Huerta, Parañaque City** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱146,160.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
