





# **DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Aurora**

as of 23 May 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On May 20, 2024, an armed conflict erupted between the Philippine Army troops and members of a Communist Terrorist Group in the Municipalities of Dipaculao and Maria Aurora, Aurora, leading to the displacement of families and individuals in the community.

The social functioning of the affected families has been disrupted due to the continuous exchange of fire between the involved groups.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region III, together with the concerned Local Government Units (LGUs) provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **694 families** or **2,413 persons** are affected in **11 barangays** in **Dipaculao** and **Maria Aurora**, **Aurora** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 352 families or 1,237 persons currently taking temporary shelter in nine (9) evacuation centers in Dipaculao and Maria Aurora, Aurora (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **nine (9) families** or **39 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **361 families** or **1,276 persons** displaced in **Dipaculao and Maria Aurora**, **Aurora** (see Annex D).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}778,280.88\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of \$\mathbb{P}761,738.88\$ from the \$\mathbb{D}SWD\$ and \$\mathbb{P}16,542.00\$ from the \$\mathbb{Local}\$ Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex E).
