

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Carol-An, Kabankalan City, Negros Occidental

as of 07 May 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 May 2024 at around 5:00PM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Carol-An, Kabankalan City, Negros Occidental between the troops of the Philippine Army (PA) and alleged members of the Communist Party of the Philippines – New People’s Army (CPP-NPA), which led to displacement of families and individuals in the community.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI, actively engaged in the response operation, and maintained continuous coordination with the concerned LGU for significant updates and possible requests for relief augmentation.
