

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Lapi, Peñablanca, Cagayan

as of 11 May 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 May 2024 at around 2AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Ebi, Brgy. Lapi, Peñablanca, Cagayan between the troops of Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and the members of Komiteng Rehiyon Cagayan Valley (KR-CV), which resulted to the displacement of families and individuals residing in the area.

A total of **65 families** or **198 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Lapi, Peñablanca, Cagayan** (see Annex A).
