I. Situation Overview

On 31 March 2024, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Limunsudan, Brgy. Rogongon, Iligan City, Lanao del Norte between the troops of Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and members of unidentified armed groups.

A total of **206 families** or **1,030 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Rogongon**, **Iligan City**, **Lanao del Norte** (see Annex A).
