

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Leon, Iloilo

as of 03 May 2024, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 02 May 2024 at around 7:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the 61<sup>st</sup> Infantry (Hunter) Battalion of the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines – New People’s Army (CPP-NPA) within the boundaries of Brgy. Bucari and Brgy. Cawilihan in Leon, Iloilo.

A total of **148 families** or **787 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Brgy. Bucari** and **Brgy. Cawilihan, Leon, Iloilo** (see Table 1).
