





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Leon, Iloilo

as of 03 May 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 02 May 2024 at around 7:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the 61st Infantry (Hunter) Battalion of the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines – New People's Army (CPP-NPA) within the boundaries of Brgy. Bucari and Brgy. Cawilihan in Leon, Iloilo.

A total of 148 families or 787 persons are affected in two (2) barangays in Brgy. Bucari and Brgy. Cawilihan, Leon, Iloilo (see Table 1).
