





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Palapag, Northern Samar

as of 08 May 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 April 2024, an armed conflict transpired in the Municipality of Palapag, Northern Samar between the troops of Philippine Army (PA) and the members of the Communist Terrorist Group (CTG), which led to the displacement of families and individuals from Barangay Bangon and Barangay Capacujan, Palapag Northern Samar.
