

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Clan Feud Incident in Brgy. Patadon, City of Kidapawan, North Cotabato

as of 17 May 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 May 2024 at around 2:00 PM, a clan feud (*Rido*) involving two (2) warring families transpired at Purok 3 and Purok 6, Brgy. Patadon, City of Kidapawan, North Cotabato. The conflict led to a casualty and the displacement of families and persons.

A total of **120 families** or **424 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Patadon, City of Kidapawan, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).
