

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Shearline in Isabela

as of 25 May 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 15-17 May 2024, a flash flood transpired in several areas in Cauayan City, Isabela due to moderate heavy rains showers. Meanwhile, on 20 May 2024, a flashflood transpired in Aurora, Isabela. As a result, there were reported affected families by the said incident. The City/Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office immediately responded to the incident and conducted immediate assessment and awareness for the possible severe hazard brought about by heavy rains.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **222 families** or **525 persons** are affected in **four (4) barangays** in **Isabela** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **11 families** or **51 persons** sought temporary shelter in **Aurora Community Centers in Brgy. Ballesteros, Aurora, Isabela** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **211 families** or **474 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **222 families** or **525 persons** displaced in **Cauayan City, Isabela** (see Annex D).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱120,580.20** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
