

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Basak, Mandaue City, Cebu

as of 24 May 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 May 2024 at around 11:53 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Basak, Mandaue City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 12:43 PM. The result of the validation, indicated 104 damaged houses, with 80 being completely destroyed and 24 partially damaged. The incident has led to displacement of 104 families' equivalent to 449 individuals.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VII, actively engaged in the response operation, and continuously coordinating with the concerned LGU for significant updates and possible requests for relief augmentation.

A total of **104 families** or **449 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Basak, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **104 families** or **449 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at **#Basak Elementary School** in **Brgy. Basak, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **104 houses** were damaged; of which, **80** are **totally damaged** and **24** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Basak, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex C).
