





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Bucalan, Canlaon City, Negros Oriental

as of 29 May 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 January 2024 at around 3PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Bucalan, Canlaon City, Negros Oriental and it was declared fire out at around 4PM.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office VII, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Canlaon City provided relief assistance to the affected family.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or five (5) persons are affected in Brgy. Bucalan, Canlaon City, Negros Oriental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or five (5) persons temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Bucalan, Canlaon City, Negros Oriental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}17,551.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected family composed of \$\mathbb{P}7,551.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}10,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
