

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Budlasan, Canlaon City, Negros Oriental

as of 29 May 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 14 March 2024 at around 2:55 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Budlasan, Canlaon City, Negros Oriental and it was declared fire out at around 3:25 PM.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office VII, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Canlaon City provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected family.

**One (1) family** or **four (4) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Budlasan, Canlaon City, Negros Oriental** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

**One (1) family** or **four (4) persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Budlasan, Canlaon City, Negros Oriental** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱15,551.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family composed of **₱7,551.00** from **DSWD** and **₱8,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
