

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Cutcutan, Valencia, Bohol as of 18 May 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 April 2024 at around 12:01 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Cutcutan, Valencia, Bohol. The fire was declared out at around 3:30 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Cutcutan, Valencia, Bohol** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are temporarily staying with their friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Cutcutan, Valencia, Bohol** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱10,759.62** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱7,759.62** from **DSWD** and **₱3,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
