## **DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Dagupan, Aglipay, Quirino**

as of 01 May 2024, 6AM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 29 April 2024 at around 03:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Dagupan, Aglipay, Quirino, and was declared fire out at around 06:00 PM. The incident has led to total destruction of a house accommodating two (2) families equivalent to six (6) individuals. According to the initial report from the MSWDO of Aglipay, affected families built a temporary shelter at the exact location of their previous residence.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region II, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Aglipay, Aquino, promptly provided relief and financial assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

A total of **two (2) families** or **six (6) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Dagupan, Aglipay, Quirino** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **two (2) families** or **six (6) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

**One (1) house** were totally damaged in **Brgy. Dagupan, Aglipay, Quirino** (see Annex C).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱50,517.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱24,882.00** from **DSWD** and **₱25,635.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
