

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Dumlog, City of Talisay Cebu as of 08 May 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 24 April 2024 at around 5:49 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Dumlog, City of Talisay, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 6:47 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **35 families** or **150 individuals** are affected in **Brgy. Dumlog, City of Talisay, Cebu** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **25 families** or **107 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Dumlog Gymnasium** in **Brgy. Dumlog, City of Talisay, Cebu** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **10 families** or **43 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **35 families** or **150 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Dumlog, City of Talisay, Cebu** (see Annex D).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **35 houses** were damaged; of which, **25** are **totally damaged** and **10** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Dumlog, City of Talisay, Cebu** (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,097,402.50** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱607,402.50** from **DSWD** and **₱ 490,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
