





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Fedelisin, Sagada, Mountain Province

as of 14 May 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 April 2024 at around 4:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Fedelisin, Sagada, Mountain Province. The fire was declared out the same day.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or one (1) person is affected in Brgy. Fedelisin, Sagada, Mountain Province (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or one (1) person is temporarily staying in a newly-built temporary shelter (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Fedelisin, Sagada, Mountain Province (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P44,200.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **P14,200.00** from **DSWD** and **P30,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit** (**LGU**) (see Annex D).

1. Standby Funds
