

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Fedelisin, Sagada, Mountain Province

as of 14 May 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 07 April 2024 at around 4:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Fedelisin, Sagada, Mountain Province. The fire was declared out the same day.

**One (1) family** or **one (1) person** is affected in **Brgy. Fedelisin, Sagada, Mountain Province** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Outside Evacuation Center

**One (1) family** or **one (1) person** is temporarily staying in a newly-built temporary shelter (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Fedelisin, Sagada, Mountain Province** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱44,200.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱14,200.00** from **DSWD** and **₱30,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
