





DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Herrero-Perez, Dagupan City, Pangasinan

20 May 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 22 April 2024 at around 3:00PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Herrero-Perez, Dagupan City, Pangasinan.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of six (6) families or 15 persons are affected in Brgy. Herrero-Perez, Dagupan City, Pangasinan (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are six (6) families or 15 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were damaged; of which, three (3) are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. Herrero-Perez, Dagupan City, Pangasinan (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}69,081.60\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}63,081.60\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}6,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
