

DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Herrero-Perez, Dagupan City, Pangasinan

20 May 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 22 April 2024 at around 3:00PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Herrero-Perez, Dagupan City, Pangasinan.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **six (6) families** or **15 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Herrero-Perez, Dagupan City, Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **six (6) families** or **15 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **six (6) houses** were damaged; of which, **three (3)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Herrero-Perez, Dagupan City, Pangasinan** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱69,081.60** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱63,081.60** from **DSWD** and **₱6,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
