



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Ingore, La Paz, Iloilo City

as of 02 May 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 30 April 2024 at around 3:58 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 2, New Site, Brgy. Ingore, La Paz, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 6:11 AM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) VI

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **15 families** or **38 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Ingore, La Paz, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **four (4) families** or **four (4) persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay Hall** of **Brgy. Ingore, La Paz, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center There are 11 families or 34 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population There are 15 families or 38 persons displaced in Brgy. Ingore, La Paz, Iloilo City (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **11 houses** were damaged; of which, **nine (9)** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Ingore, La Paz, Iloilo City** (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱94,344.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex G).
