

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Ingore, La Paz, Iloilo City as of 02 May 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 30 April 2024 at around 3:58 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 2, New Site, Brgy. Ingore, La Paz, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 6:11 AM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **15 families** or **38 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Ingore, La Paz, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **four (4) families** or **four (4) persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay Hall** of **Brgy. Ingore, La Paz, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **11 families** or **34 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **15 families** or **38 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Ingore, La Paz, Iloilo City** (see Annex E).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **11 houses** were damaged; of which, **nine (9)** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Ingore, La Paz, Iloilo City** (see Annex F).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱94,344.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex G).
