I. Situation Overview

On 08 May 2024 at around 9:45 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Magallanes, Limasawa, Southern Leyte.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or one (1) person is affected in Brgy. Magallanes, Limasawa, Southern Leyte (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There is **one** (1) family or **one** (1) person temporarily staying with their relative or friend (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Magallanes, Limasawa, Southern Leyte (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P10,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 287,297 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 218,236 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 69,061 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 95,491 FFPs available at DSWD FO VIII.
- ₱427.6 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VIII warehouses.

b. Internally Displaced Person (IDP) Protection

08 May 2024	 DSWD FO VIII coordinated with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Limasawa through its MSWDO and MDRRMO on the conduct of intake interviews, assessment, validation and profiling of the affected family by the fire incident DSWD FO VIII requested the MSWDO of Limasawa to provide Psychosocial First Aid (PFA) to the affected family and individual.

c. Other Activities

10 May 2024	DSWD FO VIII maintains close coordination with the affected LGU of Limasawa and other concerned offices for significant updates and further relief augmentation requests.
09 May 2024	 DSWD FO VIII facilitated the provision of financial assistance to the affected family through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS).


