

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Panubigan, Canlaon City, Negros Oriental

as of 29 May 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 21 February 2024 at around 2AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Panubigan, Canlaon City, Negros Oriental.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VII together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Canlaon City, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families.

A total of **three (3) families** or **10 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Panubigan, Canlaon City, Negros Oriental** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **three (3) families** or **10 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Panubigan, Canlaon City, Negros Oriental** (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱27,550.50** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱7,550.50** from **DSWD** and **₱20,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
