

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Roosevelt, Barugo, Leyte as of 30 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 April 2024 at around 3PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Roosevelt, Barugo, Leyte. The cause of fire was allegedly due to a three-year old child playing with a lighter. The fire was already extinguished when the authorities arrived. No casualty was reported.

One (1) family or **three (3) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Roosevelt, Barugo, Leyte** (see Annex A).

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **three (3) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Roosevelt, Barugo, Leyte** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱8,801.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex D).
