

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Telaje, City of Tandag, Surigao del Sur as of 13 May 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 10 May 2024 at around 10:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Gemini, Talaje, City of Tandag, Surigao del Sur. The fire was declared out at around 11:15 AM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **12 families** or **22 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Talaje, City of Tandag, Surigao del Sur** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **12 families** or **22 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Gymnasium** in **Brgy. Talaje, City of Tandag, Surigao del Sur** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **three (3) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** is **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Talaje, City of Tandag, Surigao del Sur** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱252,539.88** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
