#### I. Situation Overview

On 16 May 2024 at around 11:24 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tugas, City of Tanjay, Negros Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 9:20 PM.

A total of six (6) families or 28 persons are affected in Brgy. Tugas, City of Tanjay, Negros Oriental (see Annex A).

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are six (6) families or 28 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of five (5) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Tugas, City of Tanjay, Negros Oriental (see Annex C).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}25,000.00\$ worth of assistance was provided by the Local Government Unit (LGU) to the affected families (see Annex D).
