





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the LPG Explosion Incident in Brgy. Gabriela Silang, Baguio City

as of 29 May 2024, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 25 May 2024 at around 5:12 AM, a suspected LPG Explosion Incident occurred at Purok 3, Brgy. Gabriela Silang, Baguio City. The result of the validation, indicated seven (7) houses were partially damaged, affecting 19 families' equivalent to 63 individuals.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Cordillera Administrative Region, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Baguio City, provided relief and financial assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 19 families or 63 persons are affected in Brgy. Gabriela Silang, Baguio City (see Annex A).

## **III.** Damaged Houses

A total of seven (7) houses were partially damaged in Brgy. Gabriela Silang, Baguio City (see Annex B).

#### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}339,126.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of \$\mathbb{P}241,126.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}98,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex C).


