





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Landslide Incident in Brgy. Siana, Mainit, Surigao del Norte as of 13 May 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 May 2024, a landslide incident due to the failure of the embankment of an old tailings storage facility of a nearby mining company located in Tubod, Surigao del Norte resulted in the displacement of families and persons in Brgy. Siana, Mainit, Surigao del Norte.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **266 families** or **1,033 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Siana, Mainit, Surigao del Norte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **241 families** or **952 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in the municipalities of **Mainit and Tubod**, **Surigao del Norte** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **25 families** or **81 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 266 families or 1,033 persons displaced in Brgy. Siana, Mainit, Surigao del Norte (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 25 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Siana, Mainit, Surigao del Norte (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱2,130,983.17 worth of food and non-food items (FNIs) from DSWD was provided to the affected families (see Annex F).

1. Standby Funds

DSWD FO CARAGA attended a coordination meeting with the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) and Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office (MDRRMO) of Mainit, Office of Civil Defense (OCD) CARAGA, and representatives from the Green Resource Corporation at the Brgy. Siana Office to further assess the needs of the IDPs.
