

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Vehicular Incident in Brgy. Lapogan, Gattaran, Cagayan as of 30 May 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 May 2024 at around 6:00 AM, a vehicular incident occurred along the National Highway in Brgy. Lapogan, Gattaran, Cagayan that resulted in several casualties.

A total of **six (6) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Lapogan, Gattaran, Cagayan** (see Annex A).

A total of **₱100,000.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱60,000.00** from **DSWD** and **₱40,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex B).
