

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Vehicular Incident in Brgy. San Roque, Enrile, Cagayan

as of 01 May 2024, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 28 April 2024 at around 5:00 PM, a vehicular incident occurred along the National Highway of Brgy. San Roque, Enrile, Cagayan.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region II, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Enrile, Cagayan, provided intervention to support the immediate needs of the affected individuals by means of financial assistance and Psychosocial First Aid (PFA).

A total of **43 families** or **43 persons** are affected in **Brgy. San Roque, Enrile, Cagayan** (see Annex A).
