

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Leon, Iloilo as of 14 May 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 02 May 2024 at around 7:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the 61<sup>st</sup> Infantry (Hunter) Battalion of the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines – New People’s Army (CPP-NPA) within the boundaries of Brgy. Bucari and Brgy. Cawilihan in Leon, Iloilo that also affected the neighboring Brgy. Cagay.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **185 families** or **926 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Leon, Iloilo** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

**One (1) family** or **seven (7) persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱123,025.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex C).
