





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Leon, Iloilo

as of 14 May 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 02 May 2024 at around 7:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the 61st Infantry (Hunter) Battalion of the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines – New People's Army (CPP-NPA) within the boundaries of Brgy. Bucari and Brgy. Cawilihan in Leon, Iloilo that also affected the neighboring Brgy. Cagay.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 185 families or 926 persons are affected in three (3) barangays in Leon, Iloilo (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or seven (7) persons temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P123,025.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex C).
