

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Peñablanca, Cagayan

as of 12 May 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 May 2024 at around 2AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Ebi, Brgy. Lapi, Peñablanca, Cagayan between the troops of Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and the members of Komiteng Rehiyon Cagayan Valley (KR-CV), which resulted to the displacement of families and individuals residing in the area.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region II, immediately coordinate with the concerned LGU for significant updates and facilitation of requests for relief augmentation.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **690 families** or **2,765 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Peñablanca, Cagayan** (see Annex A).

There are **690 families** or **2,765 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).
