

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Basak, Mandaue City, Cebu

as of 05 June 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 23 May 2024 at around 11:53 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Basak, Mandaue City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 12:43 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **97 families** or **396 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Basak, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **97 families** or **396 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Basak Elementary School** in **Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **73 houses** were damaged; of which, **65** are **totally damaged** and **eight (8)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Basak, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱2,833,924.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱968,924.00** from **DSWD** and **₱1,865,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
